

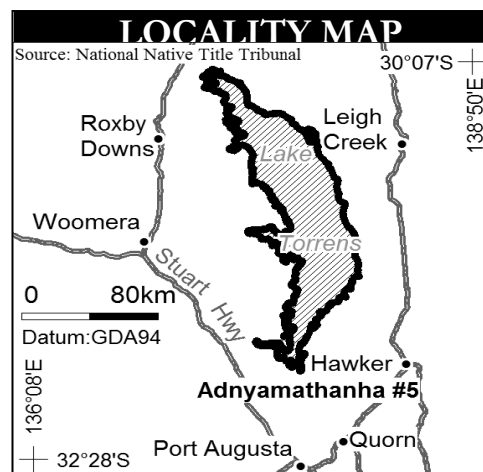
## MEETING OF ADNYAMATHANHA NO. 5 NATIVE TITLE CLAIM GROUP

**NOTICE** is given of a meeting to be held at the **HAWKER INSTITUTE HALL, HAWKER** on **FRIDAY 24 FEBRUARY 2017 COMMENCING at 1.30 pm**

The purpose of the meeting is so that the native title group may:

1. indicate to its lawyers, in pursuing the Lake Torrens appeal, whether it accepts (if the Federal Court determines that the Barngarla People have maintained relevant continuity of connection) that the Barngarla People, in addition to the Adnyamathanha People, now and since 1788 have held native title rights and interests in any part of Lake Torrens; and
2. if so, endorse its lawyers seeking a determination of native title over the whole of Lake Torrens which would accommodate both the Adnyamathanha People's rights and interests, and also the Barngarla People's rights and interests.

### **AGENDA for meeting of the Adnyamathanha Native Title Holders**

1. To consider whether to indicate acceptance that the Barngarla People, in addition to the Adnyamathanha People, now and since 1788 have held native title rights and interests in some part of Lake Torrens (a particular area will be identified at the meeting and an explanation given as to how that area has been defined).
2. To consider whether to endorse the seeking of a determination of native title over the whole of Lake Torrens which would accommodate both the Adnyamathanha People's rights and interests, and also the Barngarla People's rights and interests (a particular form of determination will be presented and explained at the meeting for consideration).

3. Any other business.
