

## **UPDATE ON RANGELEA HOLDINGS COURT ACTION**

You may have heard of a Court action that was started last week. This Court action is only related to the suspension of compensation payments.

Last week on Thursday 15 July Rangelea Holdings Pty Ltd filed an application with the Supreme Court of SA against ATLA requesting that the Court order the suspended May and June NTMA compensation payments to be paid. We were informed of this late on Wednesday 14 July.

In the Court hearing on 15 July, Justice Dart ordered the matter be adjourned until Monday 26 July to allow the other parties (ATLA, Heathgate Resources Pty Ltd and Quasar Resources Pty Ltd) time to prepare.

ATLA has appointed Lipman Karas to provide legal advice in relation to this matter. Lipman Karas has appointed Thomas McFarlane of Hanson Chambers for counsel opinion and to appear in Court on behalf of ATLA.

ATLA legal fees are currently being paid by the Commonwealth Government.

We are in discussion with our lawyers on a legal approach for this matter. We will know more after the hearing on Monday 26 July and will keep you informed.

We are drafting a detailed newsletter for the community which we plan to publish immediately after the 26 July hearing.
