Members Request under section 201-5 of the Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006 (CATSI Act)

I am aware of your Members Request dated 27 August 2024 and particularly a proposed resolution that *The Office of the Registrar of Indigenous Corporations (ORIC) remove the Administrator of ATLA forthwith and restore the process of electing directors to run ATLA in accordance with the ATLA Rulebook, the CATSI Act and the Native Title Act.*

While the Members Request was made to the Special Administrator, and the proposed resolution is not one that can be satisfied, I believe it appropriate to acknowledge the views of some members.

As has been my practice during my appointment as Registrar while ATLA has been under special administration, I will be available at the upcoming AGM to hear the concerns of members and to answer questions regarding ORIC and special administration.

An AGM is the most appropriate time for members to ask questions about the operations and governance of the corporation, including in relation to your native title rights and interests, and to receive such responses from the Special Administrator. My attendance will also allow me to hear any legitimate concerns raised with the Special Administrator.

I encourage you to attend the AGM and Information Session proposed to be held on 16 November 2024.
