







|  <p>BAC Meeting</p> | <p>A Beverley Advisory Committee (BAC) meeting was held on the 11th of June in Port Augusta. It was great to have ten Adnyamathanha representatives (including four from ATLA) working alongside four Heathgate representatives to talk about important matters related to the mining operation. The next BAC is planned for early September.</p> |
|  <p>Native Title Mining Agreement (NTMA) Review</p> | <p>Heathgate is still engaging with the Adnyamathanha Traditional Lands Association (ATLA) about the review process. The review of the NTMA has not commenced. As a first step, ATLA will work with the Adnyamathanha community to develop the review process. |  <p>Production Operations</p> | <p>The Four Mile North plant upgrades have been handed over to the operations team which was a significant project milestone. In general production is going well and some other improvements onsite include upgrading to a digital radio system and improved Wi-Fi access at camp.</p> |

|  <p>Geology Operations</p> | <p>Production drilling continues successfully at Four Mile West and East deposits. Along with delineation work and planning a new wellfield at Four Mile North.</p> |
|  <p>Cultural Heritage</p> | <p>There have been 13 cultural heritage permit inspections conducted by the Aboriginal Liaison Officers in the last three months, including 13 potential site discoveries which have been avoided and reported to the Adnyamathanha Traditional Lands Association (ATLA) and the BAC.</p> <p>Heathgate completed a cultural heritage survey in March this year for exploration drilling in the Wooltana area. The team worked safely and effectively, and some further surveys will be requested with ATLA for later this year.</p> |
|  <p>Aboriginal Liaison Officers (ALO)</p> | <p>There are currently four Adnyamathanha Heathgate staff that are performing the ALO role as set out in the NTMA. Three males and one female. Two of the male ALOs are performing that role in a dedicated capacity, due to the level of exploration drilling activity expected over the next 18 months. Heathgate is committed to gaining more female representation for the ALO team.</p> |
|  <p>Environment</p> | <p>Heathgate is operating in full compliance to all environmental conditions of operations. Rehabilitation is progressing well including a highlight of the Pannikin satellite plant being rehabilitated and reused for the Four Mile North project to minimise our environmental footprint.</p> <p>Review and maintenance of all groundwater monitoring wells have been undertaken to ensure that all 250+ ground water monitoring locations continue to be operational and compliant.</p> |

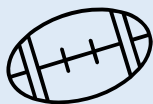
