BAC Meeting	A Beverley Advisory Committee (BAC) meeting was held on 3 rd September in Port Augusta. It was great to have eleven Adnyamathanha representatives (including four from ATLA) working alongside three Heathgate representatives and two Heathgate ALOs to talk about important matters related to the mining operation. The next BAC is planned for early December.
Native Title Mining Agreement (NTMA) Review	ATLA will communicate later in October about the NTMA review process, including provision of summary documents and access to the NTMAs for common law holders. Heathgate looks forward to engaging with the community soon on this important review. Production Operations	The new Four Mile North production and plant infrastructure is running well. Heathgate is producing from multiple deposits Four Mile West, Four Mile East, Four Mile Northeast and Four Mile North.
Geology Operations	Production drilling continues in various deposits noted above, along with exploration drilling currently underway in Wooltana and North Mulga. Heathgate also concluded an exploration drilling program on Dieri country in the Western Flinders.

Cultural Heritage	There have been 10 cultural heritage permit inspections conducted by the Aboriginal Liaison Officers in the last three months, including 14 potential cultural heritage site discoveries which have been avoided and managed by our operations and reported to the Adnyamathanha Traditional Lands Association (ATLA) and the BAC. Heathgate is reviewing requirements for another cultural heritage survey with ATLA before summer.
