Message from the Special Administrator

In my last community notice circulated on 19 December 2025, I provided an update on the Court hearing held on 18 December 2025 where we asked the Court for permission to release the Inspector's interim report to the common law holders (with some minor redactions), consistent with the decisions of the Chief Justice and the Court of Appeal, who both decided that the common law holders were entitled to information about how their native title compensation has been managed.

On 20 February 2026 the Court made orders granting our request to distribute the report and also made orders that the Inspector's costs are to be paid out of the Master Trust.

In its judgment (a copy of which is attached), the Court explained that:

- It was concerned by the lack of records produced to the Inspector by Rangelea and the Sub-Groups;
- The Inspector should continue pressing for records from the Sub-Groups; and
- Any further reports published by the Inspector will be similarly accessible to the Adnyamathanha Common Law Holders.

The subgroup leaders (except for Geraldine Anderson's group) requested a stay of the Court's orders for 48 hours to consider any application arising from the Court's orders, however no applications have been made.

As such, the Inspector's Second Interim Report will be made available for access by Adnyamathanha Common law Holders.

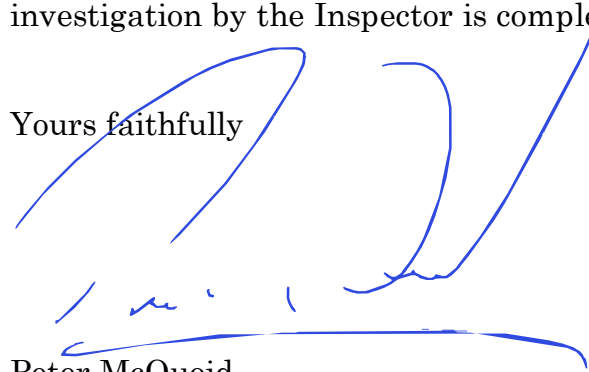
some beneficiaries and does not limit the disclosure of the Inspector's findings regarding the administration of the Master Trust.

We note that the provision of the Inspector's Final Report has been delayed as the Inspector continues to seek information and records from Rangelea and the Sub-Groups. There has been no Court order on when the Final Report is to be published, and so I cannot provide you with a due date at this time.

I will continue to keep you updated and informed of any new information or deadlines.

Compensation money (85%) will remain with the SA Supreme Court until the investigation by the Inspector is completed.
