Membership Nominations Overview

Purpose

This memo provides a high-level overview of the nomination process for NAWNTAC membership, including roles, eligibility, and requirements under the Rulebook and CATSI Act. It should be read alongside the nomination form and Rulebook (Attachment A).

1. Structure & Role of ATLA

- ATLA is a “Related Corporation” under the NAWNTAC Rulebook and is responsible for Nominating Adnyamathanha members (Rule 4.3.2)
- NAWNTAC represents three groups (Adnyamathanha, Ngadjuri, Wilyakali), each with equal representation.

2. Membership Overview

- Up to 24 members total: 8 nominated by ATLA (Adnyamathanha) and 8 from each of the other Related Corporations
- 2-year terms, commencing at the end of the AGM following nomination
- Must be: An Adnyamathanha native title holder and 18 years or older
- Must represent all native title holders collectively (CATSI Act s141.25(2))

3. Role & Responsibilities of Members

- Attending and participating in general meetings
- Voting on key decisions affecting native title rights and interests
- Representing the interests of their native title group as a whole
- Acting in accordance with:
 - The Rulebook
 - Traditional law and custom
 - The best interests of all native title holders
