

Minutes of Annual General Meeting of Adnyamathanha Traditional Lands Association (Aboriginal Corporation) RNTBC (ICN 3743)

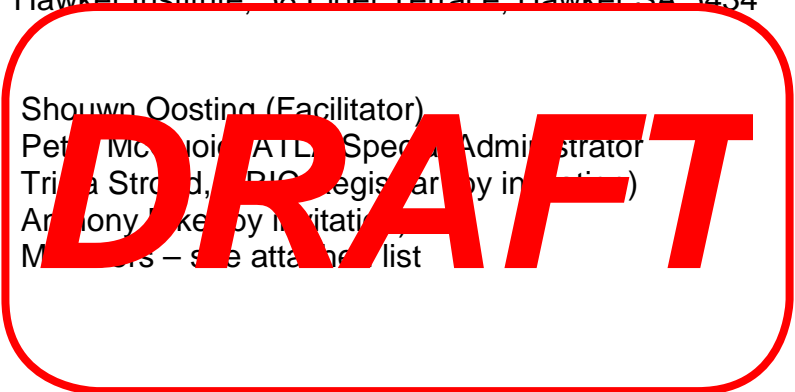

The meeting opened at 9.30 am.

1. Welcome by the Facilitator

The Facilitator welcomed all and outlined the meeting rules and various housekeeping matters.

It was noted there was only 1 item which required a decision of the members, which was confirmation of the 2024 AGM minutes.

There was a request from Vincent Coulthard Snr, that although the meeting is being run across 3 physical locations, that it is one meeting and the various locations don't have their own meeting as has occurred on a previous occasion.

5. Minutes of previous members' general meeting

The minutes of the 2024 AGM were tabled. It was noted the Adelaide location attendance sheets were missing from the minutes.

Resolution

It was resolved by ordinary resolution to accept the minutes of the ATLA General Meeting of 16 November 2024 as a true and correct record of the meeting.

6. ATLA and ATLA Trust financial statements

Anthony Pike of Moore Australia presented the financial report to members. A copy of the report is attached to the minutes.

7. Membership

Peter McQuoid addressed a question asked about the process of ATLA membership approval. It was noted there is a three-step process for approval of memberships as follows:

1. Applications are considered and if possible, a decision is made by the Corporation Advisory Group ("CAG")
2. If an applicant is unable to be identified, the application is referred to the Culture, Heritage and Native Title Committee ("CHANT") for consideration.
3. Finally, if the applicant is still not able to be identified then the application is taken to an ATLA general meeting for consideration.

Peter invited members to write to him with issues of membership for the Corporation Advisory Group to resolve.

Terrance Coulthard suggested that ATLA membership should be decided by the Common Law holders.

A question was asked if Ranglelea directors should attend this AGM. Peter McQuoid advised that Ranglelea directors have not been found guilty of any offence and hence are entitled to be in attendance.

There were concerns that an attendee at the Pt Augusta meeting location was not a member of ATLA. The facilitator asked the participants at each location to confirm those present were Adnyamathanha.

Members raised concerns about names on the membership list not being members of the Adnyamathanha community. Peter McQuoid explained what the membership requirements are as set in the Corporations Rule Book. It was noted a common issue was that female community members are listed by their maiden name.

The meeting was suspended for lunch at 12.05 pm and reconvened at 12.30pm.

8. Membership discussion continues.

Vince Coulthard Snr advised that there are 3 lists of membership being maintained:

1. ATLA membership list
2. Common Law holders membership list
3. Rangelea Trust beneficiary list

It was also noted that the membership list contains people that are deceased.

9. Special Administrator's update

Peter McQuoid provided an update to members of the Corporation's activities including the following:

- a. Tania Solar has been employed as the ATLA Business Manager.
- b. ATLA has established an office at the Pt Augusta Business office located at 2A Stirling Road Pt Augusta.
- c. Tania is currently putting together an application to submit to NIAA for business development activities.
- d. Looking to increase the ATLA membership and if those present at today's meeting know of Common Law holders that are not members encourage them to become members.
- e. In negotiations with Dept of Infrastructure and Transport to acquire 6 further houses in Leigh Creek, taking the total number of houses owned in Leigh Creek to 12.
- f. Discovery Parks has taken over the operations of the Wilpena Pound resort and the partnership agreement between Discovery Parks and ATLA is being implemented.
- g. The Native Title Mining Agreement with Heathgate Resources is about to be reviewed, noting that the royalty rate is not being reviewed. A series of meetings involving Adnyamathanha community consultation will begin shortly.

- h. Tania Solar will take over from Anthony Pike in respect to providing administration support for heritage work on behalf of ATLA.
- i. Amendments have been made to the heritage survey process, whereby Elders are being invited to participate in the selection of survey workers and consult with the engaged anthropologists.

Terrance Coulthard asked about availability of office space at Leigh Creek and cultural and heritage tours at Wilpena resort.

Rangelea matter

Peter McQuoid outlined the legal process that had taken place to date. It was noted the court appointed inspector is to table his final report to the Supreme Court in February 2026.

An interim report has been prepared, and the Supreme Court Chief Justice has agreed to release the report to Adnyamathanha Common Law holders on 10 December 2025 once it has been cleared by lawyers for both sides for personal information.

As of 31 October 2025, \$24,517,836 of Heathgate compensation money/royalties is being held in the court's bank account.

Lavene McKenzie - Ngatokorua asked if the Supreme Court will announce their findings on country. Peter McQuoid to confirm.

Continuation of Special Administration

Lavene McKenzie - Ngatokorua also asked what is required for ATLA to come out of Special Administration.

Tricia Stroud, ORIC Registrar, provided a response to the requirements for the corporation to come out of administration and is summarised as follows:

- a. The organisation is financially stable and secure.
- b. The corporation's governance is secure- the board of directors is confident and capable about the organisation's ability to operate
- c. There is a current and workable Rule Book in place
- d. There is no financial or legal issue involving the corporation that significantly impacts community.

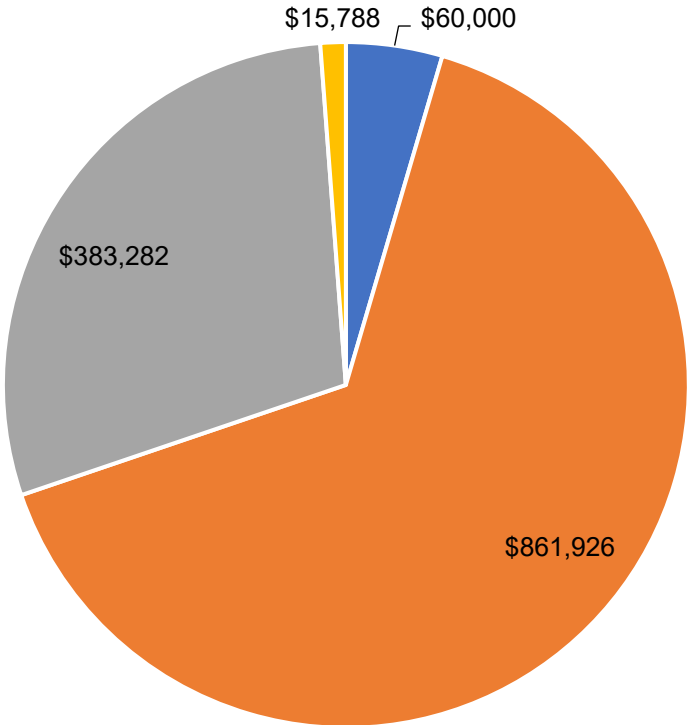

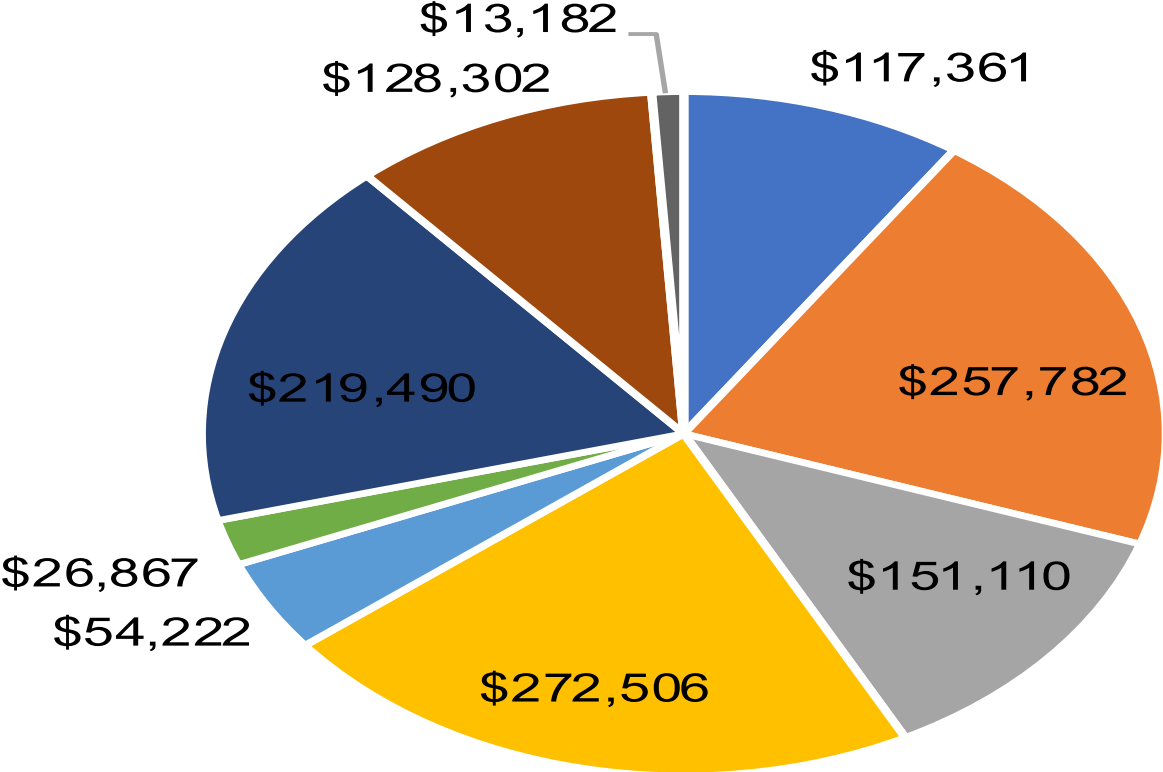

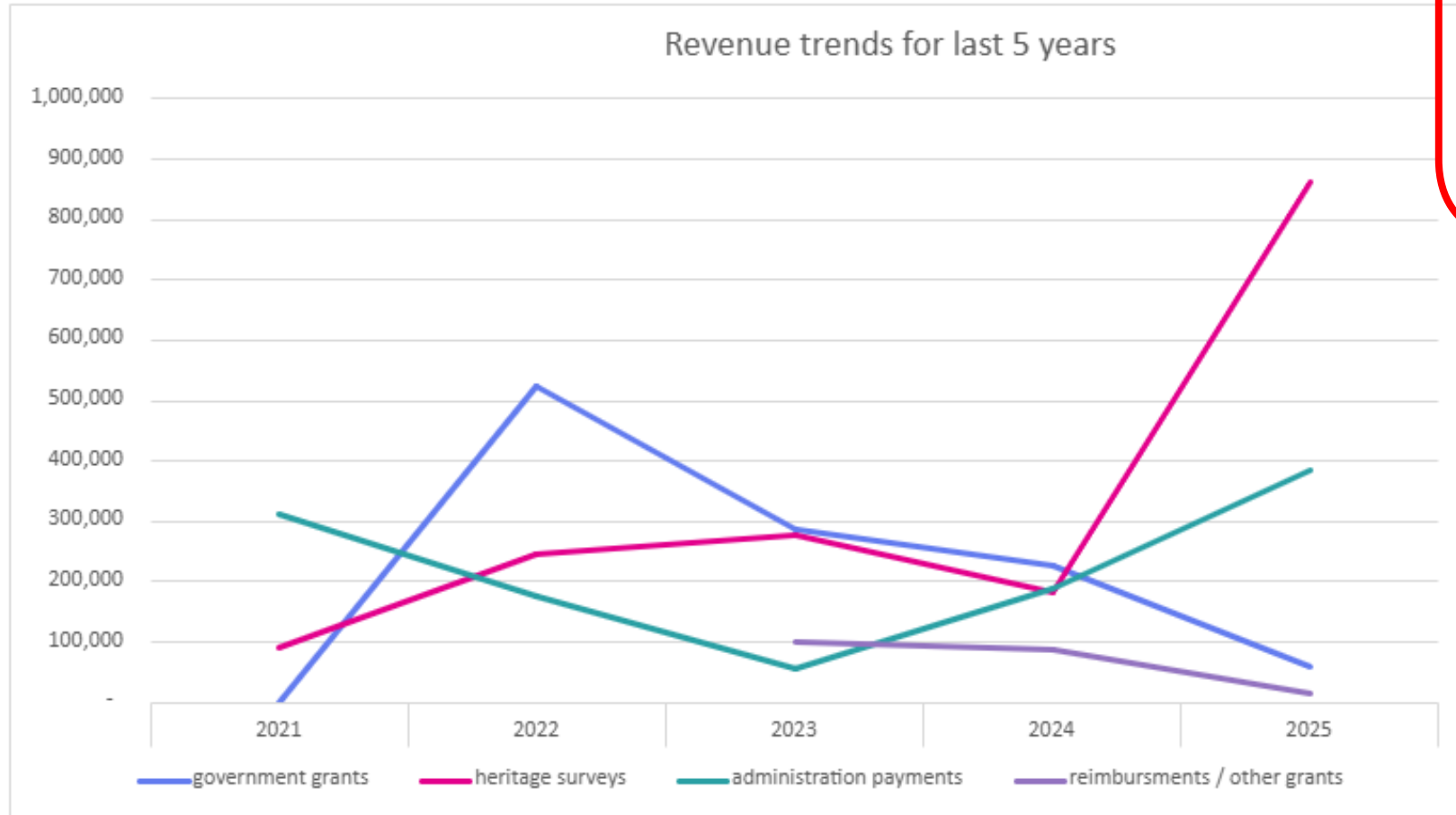

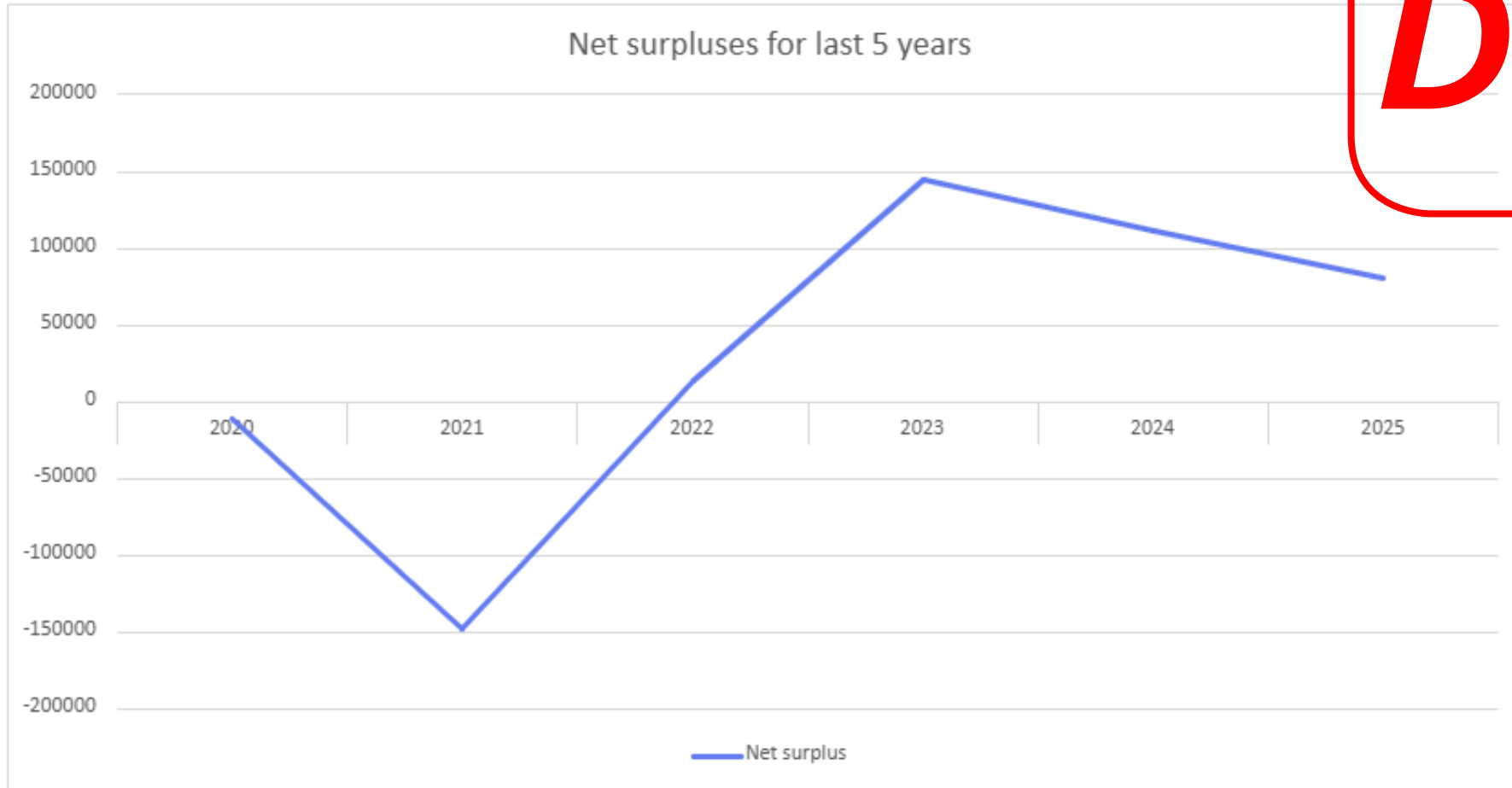
Revenue Trends for last 5 years

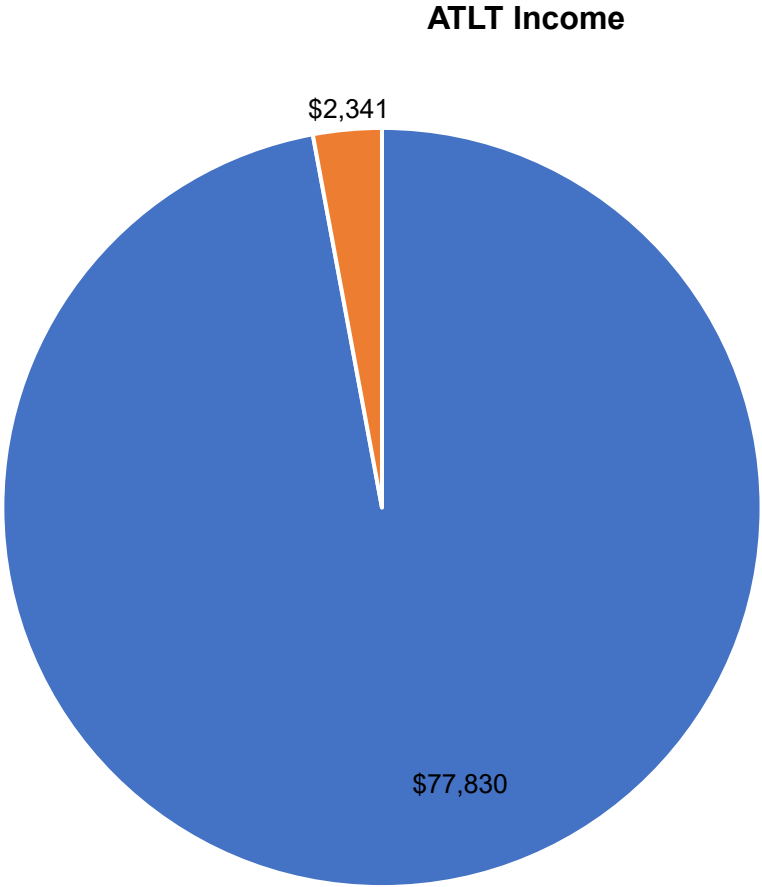


Net asset position growth over last 6 years

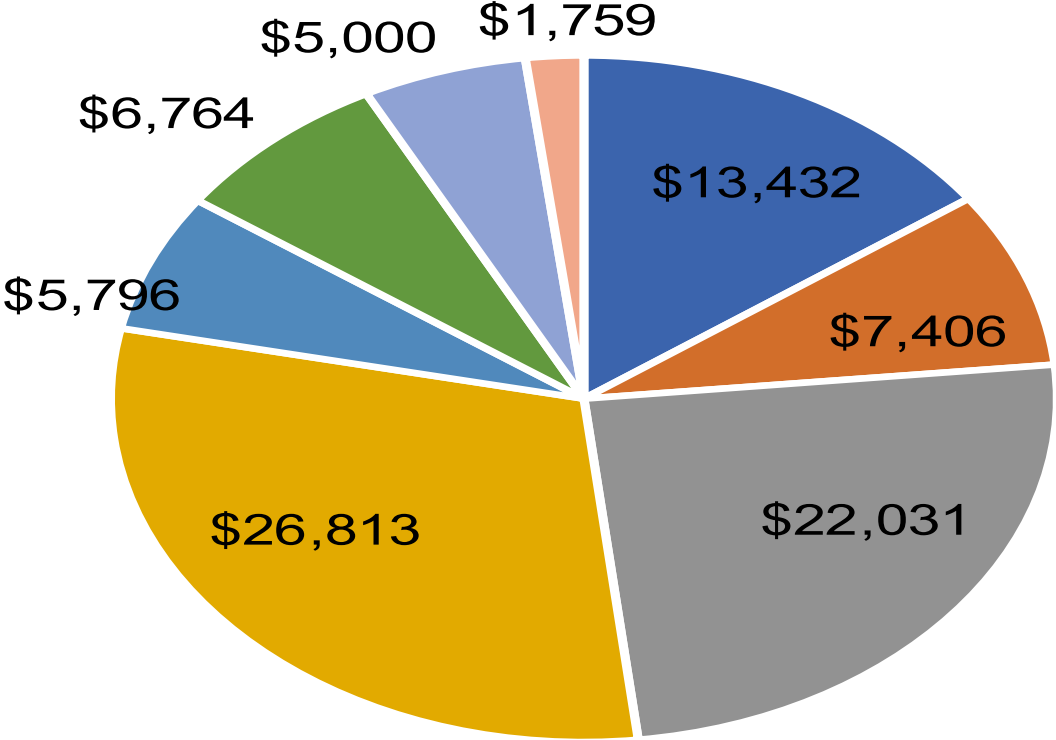

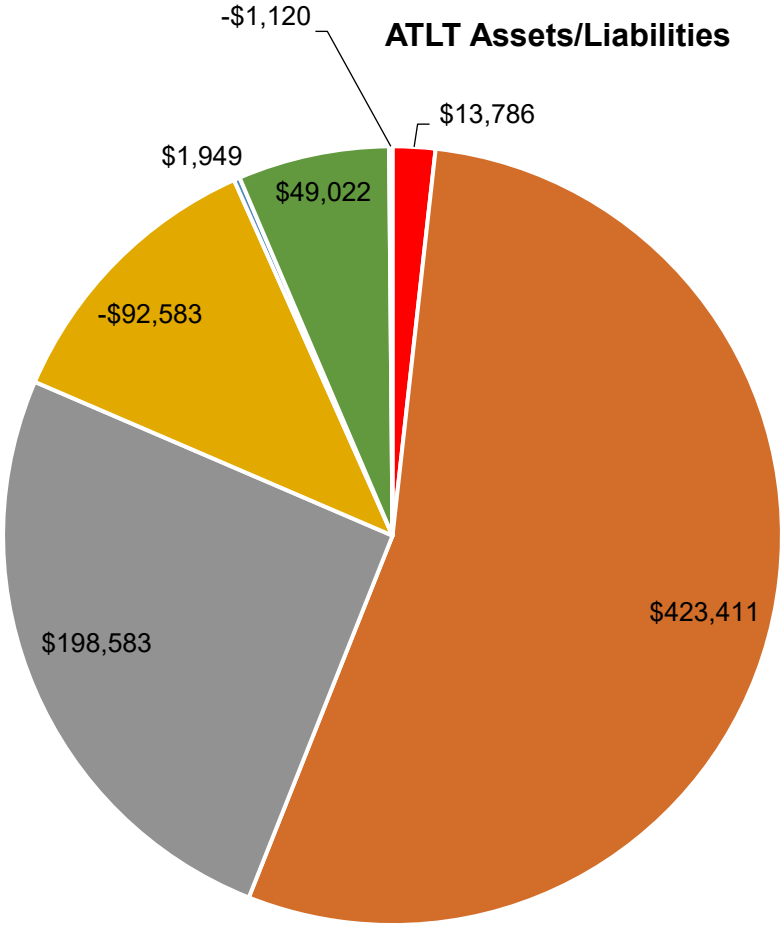

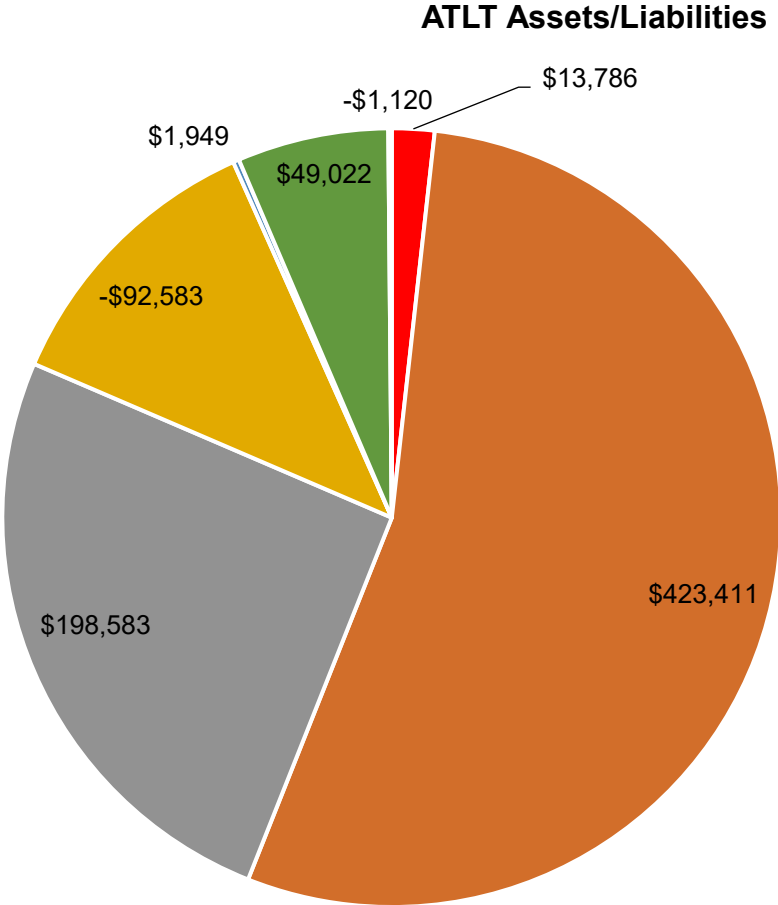
