Message from the Special Administrator

In my last community notice, circulated on 27 February 2026, I provided an update on the Inspector's Second Interim Report to the Common Law Holders (with some minor redactions).

Since that time, we have been waiting for the Supreme Court of South Australia to allocate a new Judge to the matter following the retirement of the former Chief Justice. I am pleased to advise that Justice Julie McIntyre has now been appointed to case manage the *ATLA v Rangelea* proceedings.

I have been advised yesterday that the Court has listed the matter for a directions hearing before Justice McIntyre this Friday at 12:00 pm. The purpose of the directions hearing is to determine the next procedural steps.

I have also been advised that the Inspector has provided his Third Interim Report to the Court. This report focuses on matters relating to the Master Trust. ATLA will request that the Court release the Third Interim Report to the Common Law Holders in the same manner that the Second Interim Report was released.

I will provide a further update following the directions hearing, which I expect to circulate on Tuesday, 9 June 2026. It is unlikely that any substantive decisions will be made at Friday's hearing. However, I anticipate that future hearing dates and procedural timetables may be established.

The Inspector continues his work, and I am hopeful that we will have further information as to the progress and likely timing for completion of his investigations following Friday's hearing.

I will continue to keep Common Law Holders informed of any significant developments, decisions, or deadlines as they arise.

I also remind Common Law Holders that the compensation monies (85%) will remain under the control of the Supreme Court of South Australia until the Inspector's investigation has been completed and the Court has made further orders.
