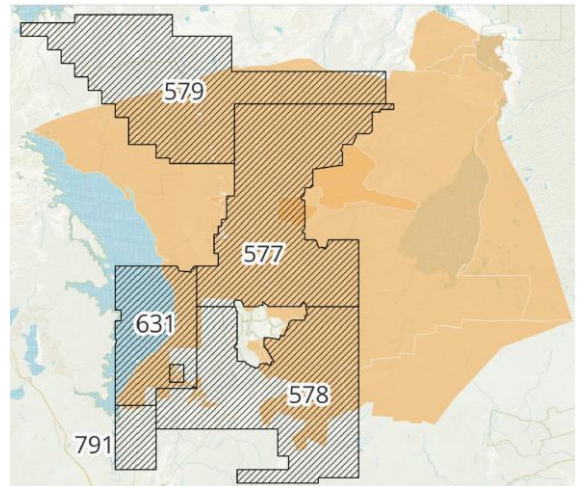


Figure: Map of PELAs 631, 577, 578, 579 and 791 for natural hydrogen and helium exploration within the ATLA determination areas (shaded orange).
