Who should attend

This meeting is open to all Adnyamathanha common law holders, according to the Adnyamathanha native title determinations (*Adnyamathanha No 1 Native Title Claim Group v The State of South Australia (No 2)* [2009] FCA 359; *Coulthard v State of South Australia* [2014] FCA 124; *Coulthard v State of South Australia* [2015] FCA 1379; and *Coulthard v State of South Australia* [2015] FCA 1380.)

Purpose

Adnyamathanha common law holders will be consulted with and asked to make decisions about providing consent to Adnyamathanha Traditional Lands Association (Aboriginal Corporation) RNTBC (**ATLA**) entering into a Section 31 Deed and Ancillar Agreement (the **Agreements**) with **Gehyra Exploration Pty Ltd** c/- Gehyra Energy Pty Ltd (**Gehyra**).

The Petroleum Exploration Licence (**PEL**) and Petroleum Exploration Licence Applications (**PELAs**) covered by the Agreements (and any associated retention licences) are

- PELA 791

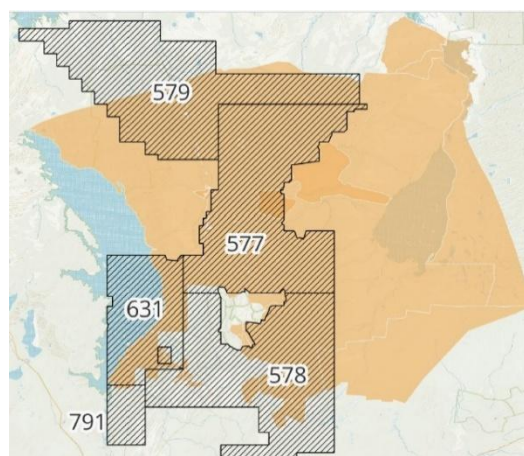
