Message from the Special Administrator

Dear Common Law Holders

This is an update on the court hearing this morning before McIntyre J. The orders made by the Court are set out below.

A journalist from the Sydney Morning Herald applied to watch the hearing by video link. A journalist from the Advertiser was present in court. Rangelea argued that the court hearing should be closed to the public, including the press, and that only Common Law Holders and the parties should be able to attend. The Court dismissed Rangelea's application to stop the Sydney Morning Herald journalist observe this morning's hearing by video link.

Rangelea is to file any further application about media access by 24 September 2026. If Rangelea makes an application, the Court will hear any argument about media access at a hearing in October 2026 (date to be advised).

The Court will also hear argument at the hearing in October 2026 about the release of the Inspector's Third and Fourth Interim Reports to Common Law Holders. ATLA wants both the Third and Fourth Interim Reports to be released to the Common Law Holders with only a few items of sensitive personal information blacked out. ATLA told the Court it wants this dealt with as soon as possible.

Some of the Sub-Groups want to provide more information to the Inspector before he finishes his investigation. The Inspector wrote to the Sub-Groups asking for all information in September and October 2025, almost one year ago. The Court has ordered that all further information is to be provided to the Inspector by 9 October 2026.

The Court has made an order that the Inspector is to complete his investigation and deliver his final report on the administration of the Adnyamathanha Master Trust to the Court by 30 October 2026.

A number of Common Law Holders attended the hearing this morning by Webex link, after some technical issues. The Webex link is for watching the hearing only not for talking to the Court. Only the parties through their lawyers talk to the Court. Please keep your camera and microphone turned off during the hearing and watch and listen only.

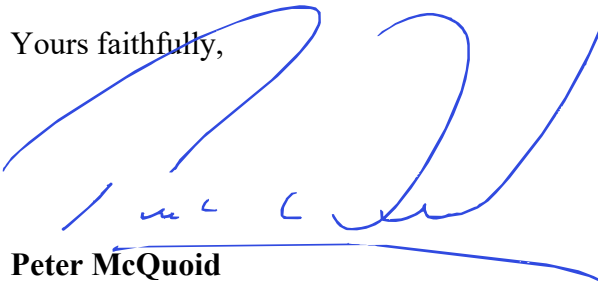
Common Law Holder). If you already registered for this morning's hearing, there is no need to register again – your name is already on the list.

8. The Inspector is to supply the Court with any addendum to the Fourth Interim Report and the Final Report by Friday 30 October 2026 at 5:00pm.

At the same time as providing a copy to the Court, the Inspector is to also provide a copy of any addendum to the Fourth Interim Report and the Final report to the solicitors for each of the parties and the interested parties, and their accountants and/or financial advisers, pursuant to section 84F(b) of the Trustee Act 1936 (SA).
10. The solicitors of the First to Seventh Interested Parties are permitted to provide the Fourth Interim Report and any addendum to the accountants and/or financial advisers of the interested parties pursuant to section 84F(b) of the Trustee Act 1936 (SA).
11. The matter is listed for directions on Tuesday, 10 November 2026 at 9:00am.
